The Art Jazzed Up exhibition explores how creative people interpret music and the inspirational results of bringing the ephemeral nature of sound back into the physical realm. The 80 artists and their artwork at The Shaw Gallery today have all been inspired by music. The artists were limited to listen to the compositions of Bill Mudge, Mike DiRubbo, Duncan Eagles, Max Luthert and Peter Ibberton. What resulted was a fantastic and eclectic mix submitted by artists of all ages and disciplines from around the world.

Each musician was asked to choose their top 3 images and these were shortlisted for the exhibition. Alban Low Award with one artist receiving a cash prize on the opening night.

All 250 artworks were exhibited in CD jewel cases and will be on display until the end of the Autumn term 2013 at The Shaw Gallery, Trinity School, Croydon.
